

EURACT Membership fees - 2015

Fees are based on the country gross domestic product (GDP) at purchasing power parity (PPP) per capita (pc) as estimated by the IMF (International Monetary Fund). Countries are placed in the different "cells" according to these IMF-figures. Fees for a given year are based on newest data available in the year before
