

EURACT Membership fees - 2016

Fees are based on the country gross domestic product (GDP) at purchasing power parity (PPP) per capita (pc) as estimated by the IMF (International Monetary Fund). Countries are placed in the different "cells" according to these IMF-figures. Fees for a given year are based on newest data available in the year before (World Economic Outlook Database, October 2015)

Countries with GDP at PPP pc of > Curr. Int. \$ 39,999: fee of 50 Euro	Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Iceland, Ireland, Netherlands, Norway, Sweden, Switzerland, UK Total: 13 countries
